

## ALCO EMS ePCR Updates - Crew Notification for January 1<sup>st</sup> 2019

The following fields in ePCR will be updated January 1<sup>st</sup> 2019. Most updates have already been implemented as they did not affect rules, policies or have no operational impact. A “Multi-Agency ePCR Improvement Committee” comprised of Field User Reps., Agency QA Reps. and EMS Agency personnel have reviewed, vetted and approved the requests submitted by field users. Please continue to submit requests to your agency representatives throughout the year for consideration during the next review process, or sooner if needed.

- There are not too many updates this year as many were implemented over the past couple of months.
- The application will be upgraded late January to early February. There are NEMSIS required updates and a new feature that will help complete PCR’s quicker using templates that can be customized by each agency. For some types of documentation, it can reduce end-user input requirements by up to 75%. More information to follow in early January.
- The State EMSA is implementing additional rules on January 15<sup>th</sup> 2019. Currently the only additional rule that affects the end user is:
  - Blood Glucose Value is entered in the Vital Sign Section it will now require you to complete a “**Glucose Measurement**” intervention. Most Selections have been defaulted in the intervention. It will require the time performed, crew member and certification level performed by. All other selections should be confirmed prior to completion.
